Note - The University of North Texas Health Sciences Center at Fort Worth/Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine and NYIT-COM's émigré program applicants are not included in this analysis because the data are not part of the AACOMAS database. UNTHSC/TCOM receives its applications through the Texas Medical and Dental School Application Service.

Notes: In April 2015, the AAMC launched a new version of the MCAT exam. Scores are reported in four sections: 1) Chemical and Physical Foundations of Biological Systems (CPBS), 2) Critical Analysis and Reasoning Skills (CARS), 3) Biological and Biochemical Foundations of Living Systems (BBLs), and 4) Psychological, Social, and Biological Foundations of Behavior (PSBB). Some medical schools accept scores from both the new and old exams. Accordingly, applicants vary in which scores they include with their applications. Only the highest total MCAT score is used for individuals who took the exam more than once.

Dashed cells indicate the MCAT/UGPA range combinations with fewer than 10 applicants; blank cells indicate MCAT/UGPA range combinations with zero applicants. Totals are the sum of all applicants and matriculants, including instances where fewer than 10 applicants from a single cell were removed.
